Math – Our lessons focus on finding patterns to solve story problems, using repeated addition to add equal groups and using arrays with repeated addition.

Religion – We will pause our learning focusing on the Liturgical Calendar and spend time reviewing the rosary. While discussing and praying the prayers at each bead, students will create a rosary project.

Social Studies – Students will present their communities to the class. Students will also take a short quiz to check for understanding of the chapter we read together in class.

Science - We begin our Matter unit where students will be introduced to the three states of matter – solid, liquid, and gas. Students will identify the properties of these states of matter, compare and contrast the properties of solids and liquids and recognize that matter can go through changes without physically changing the material it is made of.
